

The 2022 flood relief was an enormous activity in KP and Sind provinces, which is still going, especially the rehabilitation operation and provision of clean drinking water projects.



This is to inform you that that the Government of Pakistan is pleased to register and sign MoU with M/S Khubaib Foundation for a period upto 5th January, 2025 for the project " (i) Orphan Boarder, Care (ii) Orphan Boarder, Education and Sponsorship Program (iii) Constriction of Hostel Building (Ground Floor) at Haripur (iv) Construction of Masjid at Alipur, Muzaffargarh (v) Construction of Masjid at Besham, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (vi) Construction of Masjid at Chitral, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (vii) Construction of Masjid at Gujranwala, Punjab (viii) Construction of Masjid at Haripur, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (ix) Construction of Masjid at Swaibi, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (x) Construction of Orphanage / School Building for Girls at Rara, Muzaffarabad, AJK" located all over Pakistan with the following conditions:

- Annual Action Plan (APA) of every new Activity/Project involving foreign funding will be required to be submitted to EAD along with the Project and Financing Agreement with the Donor/INGO well in time before commencing the project
- Organization will seek concurrence of EAD if it changes its thematic area of working and expands geographical location of its activities other than that given in the signed MoU.
- iii. Organization will work with registered INGOs.
- Not to use controversial terms like "Peace & Conflict Resolution, IDPs etc in your annual reports or any other Documents/Correspondence/Agreements.
- v. Organization will not employ any individual of Indian and Israeli nationality/origin.
- vi. The organization will declare to the Government all foreign contributions, along with the terms and conditions of those contributions, as well as details of all bank accounts maintained by it. The organization will maintain accounts under internationally recognized accounting standards, get these accounts audited on an annual basis by a registered Chartered Accountancy firm and will provide to the Government a copy of the audited annual statements, alongwith a certificate from the Auditors to the effect that the foreign contributions have been utilized for the objectives of the organization as specified in the MOU.
- vii. Organization shall receive foreign contributions through banking channel only. However, while doing so, it will have to comply with the Anti Money Laundering and other relevant rules as per applicable in Pakistan
- viii. Limit your work to concrete socio-economic activities.
- ix. NGO will not indulge in any advocacy related activity during project execution.
- NOC for current project only; completion report will be forwarded by NGO to EAD.
- xi. No deviation from stated project and location without security clearance from EAD.





KHUBAIB EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

The main goal of Khubaib Foundation is to protect and educate orphans. In order to give them a sense of belonging to the community and to teach them how to be decent Muslim citizens.

Khubaib Foundation schools and colleges are fulfilling the national and international overall goals, objectives and targets of higher education of the orphans/deserving students and day scholars. Efficiency enhancement rules has been established for best output to re-utilize the existing system with a view to cater spiritual, psychological and social needs of individuals, orphans and society and trying to provide non-discriminatory quality education for integrated personality development of individuals and orphans, who will embrace learning to excel their own future.



KHUBAIB SCHOOL & COLLEGE HARIPUR

In the year 2006 chairman Khubaib Foundation, Mr. Nadeem Ahmad Khan embarked to realize his dream of "An Educational City" in reality. The project was planned on an enormous 313 Kanals of land. Its basic aim was to provide quality social education along with outclass boarding facility to the children of Pakistan.



Khubaib Foundation educational system is amongst the most prominent social educational system in Pakistan. Our primary aim is to provide a learning environment dedicated to quality education with three-pronged strategy; spiritual education, academics and physical training. Haripur project was started with middle school and subsequently raised to inter level. The first headmistress was Madam Zainab an educationist from Canada. In April 2006, Khubaib College Haripur was affiliated with Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education (BISE) Abbottabad, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK) a northern province of Pakistan. It was upgraded to the Intermediate level in 2015.

We had constructed new school building with the capacity of 800 students and 3 hostel buildings with capacity of 600 boarder students, new mess hall, prayer area, VTC and indoor activity area. Fourth hostel building is also under construction. We are also planning the construction of accommodation for faculty and a new swimming pool for the students. Khubaib College Haripur is planned to be upgraded to university level in near future.

KHUBAIB COLLEGE RARA MUZAFFARABAD

Khubaib College Rara is established in 2008 at Rara Muzaffarabad Azad Kashmir on the area of 31 Kanals. The level of education is Intermediate, and is affiliated with Federal Board. 400 Students are studying at Khubaib College Rara. Since its inception the college has served significantly the local community for quality education as well as housed a number of orphan students of Muzaffarabad and adjoining areas.



KHUBAIB COLLEGE RUMI

Khubaib College Rumi was established in 2002. At the area of 3 Kanals. The level of education of Khubaib College Rumi is Matric and it is affiliated with ministry of Maarif Islamic Emaraat Afghanistan. Total number of students studying in RUMI are 234. Khubaib Foundation educational system is amongst the most prominent social educational system in Pakistan.



KHUBAIB SCHOOL & COLLEGE SARGODHA

Khubaib College for girls Sargodha was established in January 2013 with boarding / lodging facilities within the college. The land of college was donated by Gen. (R) Hameed Gul. The area of college is 125 kanals out of which 45 kanals is constructed area comprising of college campus and hostel. The college is premier English medium educational institution, founded to meet the present requirement of the area for equality education. We believe that knowledge is power and time is money. Without caring for time and urge for knowledge, no nation can strive. To inculcate sense of understanding, comprehension and importance of time and knowledge, in the future generations. It is imparting education up to the Matric level, affiliated with Board of Intermediate and Secondary education (BISE) Sargodha.

We believe that a truly educated person should achieve a significant depth of understanding in relevant academic discipline. We encourage our students to become more than just narrow specialists. We produce an educated person in the world of ideas, who values learning for its own sake as well as the society.

Khubaib College Gilgit was established as orphanage in 2015. It houses 50 orphan students.

Presently 75 students are studying in different Universities of the Turkey on Turkish government scholarship.








ORPHANS' PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES

- The year 2022 started with the same untoward challenges of pandemic and financial insecurities. Khubaib Taekwondo Academy kept on moving with slow pace in 2022. Due to financial constraints, KTA could not execute its annual activity calendar this year. Training span remained stuck for only 6 months in 2022 and classes remained shut for the rest of period. Due to uncertainty and grim economic situation the academy postponed belt promotion tests: annual black belt graduation ceremony and annual inter Khubaib Taekwondo Championship as well as all recreational activities as planned previously.
- Due to lack of funds, the academy could not manage to purchase basic mandatory equipment even uniform for the players. The academy had to shut down TKD activities at KCH. The academy lost human capital in 2022 as 40 % of our prepared sportsmen (from each belt) had left due to circumstances. Despite all the challenges, the academy kept progressing, with a slow pace.
- In February, 20 players of KTA participated in Islamabad inter-club Taekwondo Championship and won 3 Gold, 3 Silver and 5 Bronze medals.
- In November 2022, two players of KTA participated in Pakistan Open International Taekwondo Championship but failed to bring any medal to home, in the same month, nine players of KTA participated in Under-21 KPK Games and won 1 Gold and 5 Bronze medals.
- Eight Players of KTA participated in IGFC KPK National Taekwondo Championship held at (KF Fort Tank) Waziristan district of KPK in December this year. Players won 2 Gold, 1 Silver and 3 Bronze medals.

CONSTRUCTION OF 3rd HOSTEL BUILDING AT HARIPUR PROJECT:



RAMADAN PROGRAM - 2022

Khubaib Foundation distributed fresh ration packs among 4,000 families of Pakistan in the holy month of Ramadan 2022. Each pack had ration of one week for a family of 5-6 adults. The packet had 4 kg sugar, 4 kg rice, 3 kg pulses, 385g tea, 10 kg flour and 2 liters of cooking oil. These packets were distributed in Khubaib Educational Institutes in Skardu, Sargodha, Muzaffarabad, Rara, Azad Kashmir, and poor/deserving people of Skardu, Gilgit, Azad Kashmir, Tharparkar, Muzaffargarh, Rawalpindi and Islamabad.

Iftar packets were also distributed among the 466 deserving families in Ramadan so that they could enjoy the moments of Iftar. These packets had good quality dates, apples, bananas, snacks, samosa, juices, lemons etc. These eatables were distributed by Khubaib Foundation with the collaboration partner NGOs.

Khubaib Foundation Pakistan and Zakat Foundation of America also distributed food stuff among 312 families of Pakistan in Ramadan-2022. 20 kg bag of flour, 10 kg rice, 10 kg sugar, 5 kg pulses, 5-liter cooking oil and Iftar packets having dates, apples, snacks and other eatables were distributed by both of the organizations.

Khubaib Foundation and WEFA (Another philanthropic organization) distributed another cache of iftar packets and food items among 367 poor families and distributed Eid gifts among 246 orphans and Zakat among 1000 orphans of Khubaib Foundation.



QURBAN PROGRAM - 2022

Khubaib Foundation slaughtered cows in 2022. The slaughtering took place at Khubaib College Haripur (KCH), Head Office Islamabad, Khubaib College RARA, Muzaffarabad (KCR), Khubaib College Gilgit (KCG), Khubaib College Skardu (KCS), and Khubaib Girls College Sargodha (KGCS). Meat was distributed amongst poor and deserving people in backward/far flung areas of Gilgit-Baltistan (GB), Haripur & Mansehra-KP province, Muzaffarabad & Bagh-AJK, Sargodha & Muzaffargarh-Punjab, Rawalpindi, CDA workers and dwellers of slum areas in Capital territory of Islamabad etc.



DISTRIBUTION OF EID CLOTHES:

Khubaib Foundation also distributed clothes among 1000 orphans during Ramadan. Purpose of the activity was to share the burden of those families who don't have sufficient resources to buy new clothes on the eve of Eid-ul-Fitr. Pair of clothes, shoes, undergarments were distributed before the Eid. 240 Eid gifts donated by WEFA for



orphans of Khubaib Foundation were also distributed.

AQEEQA PROGRAM:

Khubaib Foundation slaughtered 10 cows in the month of March 2022 at Khubaib College Gilgit (KCG), Khubaib College Haripur (KCH), Khubaib College RARA (KCR), Khubaib College Muzaffargarh (KCM), Khubaib Girls College Sargodha (KGCS) and Muhammadan School of Advance Learning (MSAL).

02 cows and 06 goats were slaughtered in the month of April 2022 at Khubaib College Haripur (KCH), Khubaib Girls College Sargodha (KGCS) and MSAL Rawalpindi.

GLOBAL HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE AFGHAN RELIEF AND AID

Millions of Afghans are on the verge of facing a catastrophic famine, and their lives are at stake. Afghanistan is experiencing one of the worst droughts in 27 years, and as a result food, water and supplies are extremely scarce.


Khubaib foundation was on the ground delivering vital food packs, water storage kits and winter clothing, as well as providing medical care and supporting displaced families. Aftermaths of Flood

Floods have huge social ramifications for societies and people. As most people are well aware, the immediate impacts of flooding includes loss of human life, damage to property, destruction of crops, loss of livestock, and deterioration of health conditions owing to waterborne diseases.



The destruction caused by flood is massive and particularly impacting the poorest and most vulnerable people. More than **8 million** displaced people are now facing a health crisis.

Khubaib Foundation's Response

Khubaib Foundation initiated the flood response from July 7th, 2022. Since then our teams are on ground serving flood victims providing relief work in all four provinces i.e. Balochistan, Sindh, Punjab, KPK and Gilgit Baltistan. However the devastation is far too much and flood victims are still waiting for help.
