Dear Sir,

This is to inform you that that the Government of Pakistan is pleased to register and sign MoU with M/S **Khubaib Foundation** for a period upto **5th January, 2025** for the project “ (i) Orphan Boarder, Care (ii) Orphan Boarder, Education and Sponsorship Program (iii) Constriction of Hostel Building (Ground Floor) at Haripur (iv) Construction of Masjid at Alipur, Muzaffargarh (v) Construction of Masjid at Besham, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (vi) Construction of Masjid at Chitral, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (vii) Construction of Masjid at Gujranwala, Punjab (viii) Construction of Masjid at Haripur, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (ix) Construction of Masjid at Swaibi, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (x) Construction of Orphanage / School Building for Girls at Rara, Muzaffarabad, AJK” located all over Pakistan with the following conditions;

- i. Annual Action Plan (APA) of every new Activity/Project involving foreign funding will be required to be submitted to EAD along with the Project and Financing Agreement with the Donor/INGO well in time before commencing the project
 - ii. Organization will seek concurrence of EAD if it changes its thematic area of working and expands geographical location of its activities other than that given in the signed MoU.
 - iii. Organization will work with registered INGOs.
 - iv. Not to use controversial terms like “Peace & Conflict Resolution, IDPs etc in your annual reports or any other Documents/Correspondence/Agreements.
 - v. Organization will not employ any individual of Indian and Israeli nationality/origin.
 - vi. The organization will declare to the Government all foreign contributions, along with the terms and conditions of those contributions, as well as details of all bank accounts maintained by it. The organization will maintain accounts under internationally recognized accounting standards, get these accounts audited on an annual basis by a registered Chartered Accountancy firm and will provide to the Government a copy of the audited annual statements, alongwith a certificate from the Auditors to the effect that the foreign contributions have been utilized for the objectives of the organization as specified in the MOU.
 - vii. Organization shall receive foreign contributions through banking channel only. However, while doing so, it will have to comply with the Anti Money Laundering and other relevant rules as per applicable in Pakistan
 - viii. Limit your work to concrete socio-economic activities.
 - ix. **NGO will not indulge in any advocacy related activity during project execution.**
 - x. **NOC for current project only; completion report will be forwarded by NGO to EAD.**
 - xi. **No deviation from stated project and location without security clearance from EAD.**

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF KHUBAIB FOUNDATION

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of **KHUBAIB FOUNDATION (The Foundation)** which comprise of the statement of financial position as at June 30, 2023, and the statement of income and expenditure, statement of comprehensive income, the statement of change in general reserve and the statement of cash flows for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the **KHUBAIB FOUNDATION** as at June 30, 2023, and its financial performance and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with the accounting standards for Not for Profit Organizations (NPOs) issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP) and International financial reporting standards for Small & Medium Sized Entities (IFRS for SMEs) issued by International Accounting Standard Board (IASB) and adopted by the Foundation.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the International Standards on Auditing (ISAs) as applicable in Pakistan. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Foundation in accordance with the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants' "Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants" as adopted by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (the Code), and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Trustees and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

The trustees are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the accounting standards for NPOs issued by the ICAP and International financial reporting standards for Small & Medium Sized Entities issued by the IASB, and for such internal control as the trustees determine is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, the trustees are responsible for assessing the Foundation's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matter related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless Trustees either intends to liquidate the Foundation or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

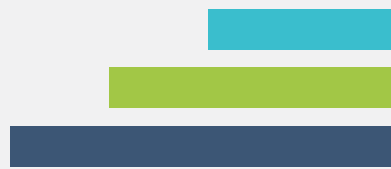
Empowering Through Sports

In a stride towards holistic development, Khubaib Foundation proudly introduced the Khubaib Taekwondo Academy for its students. This academy serves as a platform for both boys and girls, fostering self-confidence & providing an avenue for engaging in extracurricular activities. Throughout 2023, students from Khubaib Academy showcased their skills in National & International events, securing notable positions with 4 Gold, 2 Silver & 5 Bronze Medals. The academy also organized internal events, including Belt Test Promotions and the Inter Khubaib Championship, creating opportunities for students to excel, grow & develop essential life skills through the discipline of Taekwondo.

Concurrently, at Khubaib School and College Hamzawallah, the construction of new classrooms has taken place, aiming to provide enhanced educational spaces for orphans.

Khubaib Foundation along with modern education is committed to the holistic education and spiritual development of the individuals under its care. During the Year 2023, Fifteen students from Khubaib Madrisas have accomplished their Hifz e Quran Course, a significant achievement marked by a ceremony held at Usmania Masjid H-8 and Khubaib Community Centre in Muzaffargarh. In a heartening moment, the Chairman Khubaib Foundation personally distributed certificates, offered his best wishes, and presented prizes to the graduating stars. Having successfully built over 700 wells and 10 filtration plants across water scarce areas of Pakistan, Khubaib Foundation is committed to ensuring both immediate and sustained access to clean water. This concerted effort has had a profound and positive impact on innumerable lives across Pakistan.



Health Care Support Program

The Khubaib Foundation under its health care support program has prioritized providing crucial healthcare assistance to families facing challenges. This commitment encompasses various services, including the implementation of eye care camps with cataract operations in flood-affected areas of Sindh.

Additionally, the foundation organizes free medical camps and delivers essential medicines & checkups in different regions of Pakistan & Azad Jammu & Kashmir.



Khubaib Empowerment Projects

Khubaib Foundation through its Empowerment Project for youth & women have extended sustainable sources of income, fostering empowerment among individuals and families facing economic challenges. In 2023 The foundation provides financial support to underprivileged individuals, facilitating the distribution of auto-rickshaws, bicycles, ice cream carts, milky cows, milky goats, and sewing machines. Through the Self-Empowerment Project, where the Khubaib Foundation provides financial assistance to impoverished individuals, our aim is to break the cycle of poverty by enabling economic independence and creating a foundation for a brighter and more prosperous future.

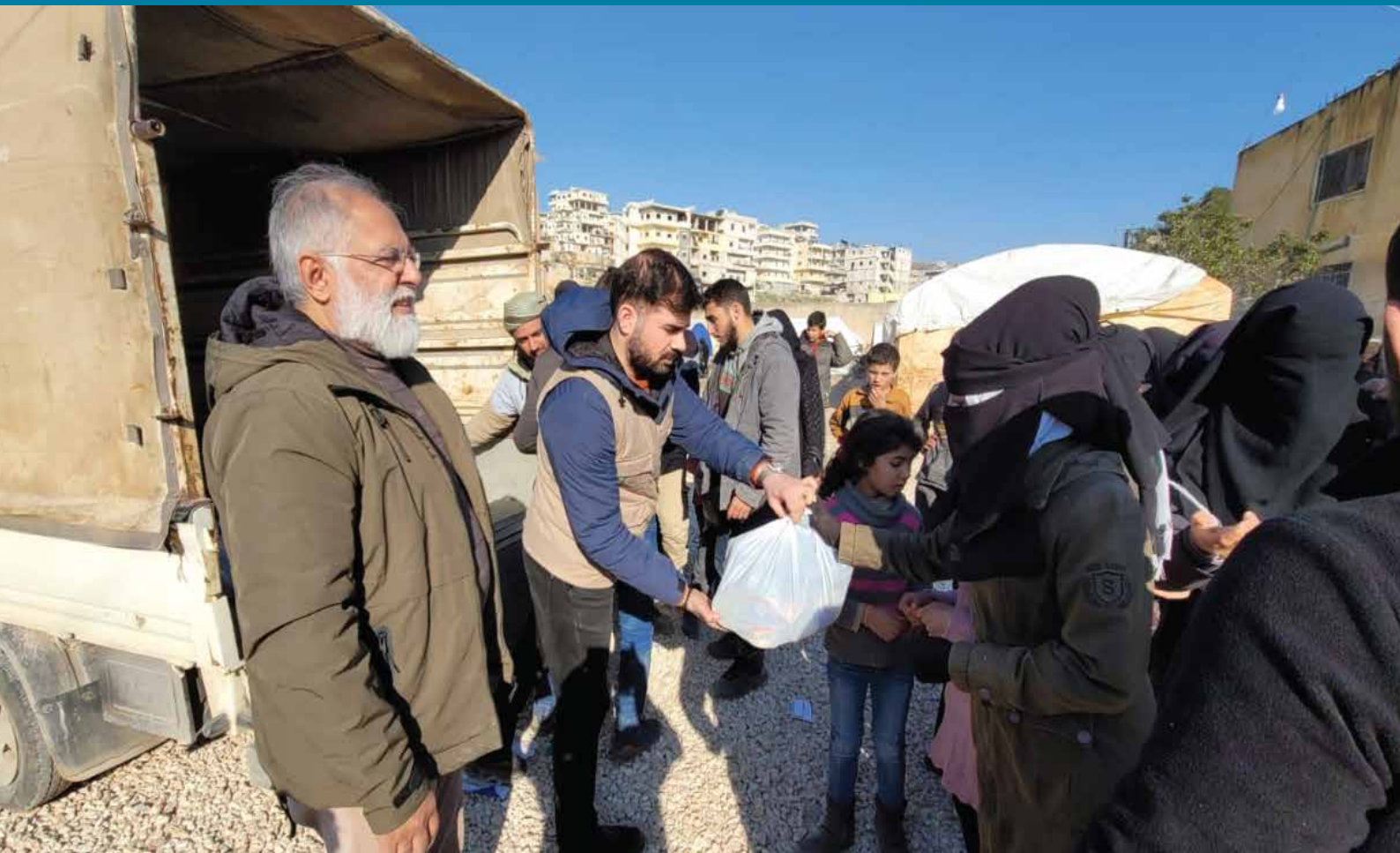

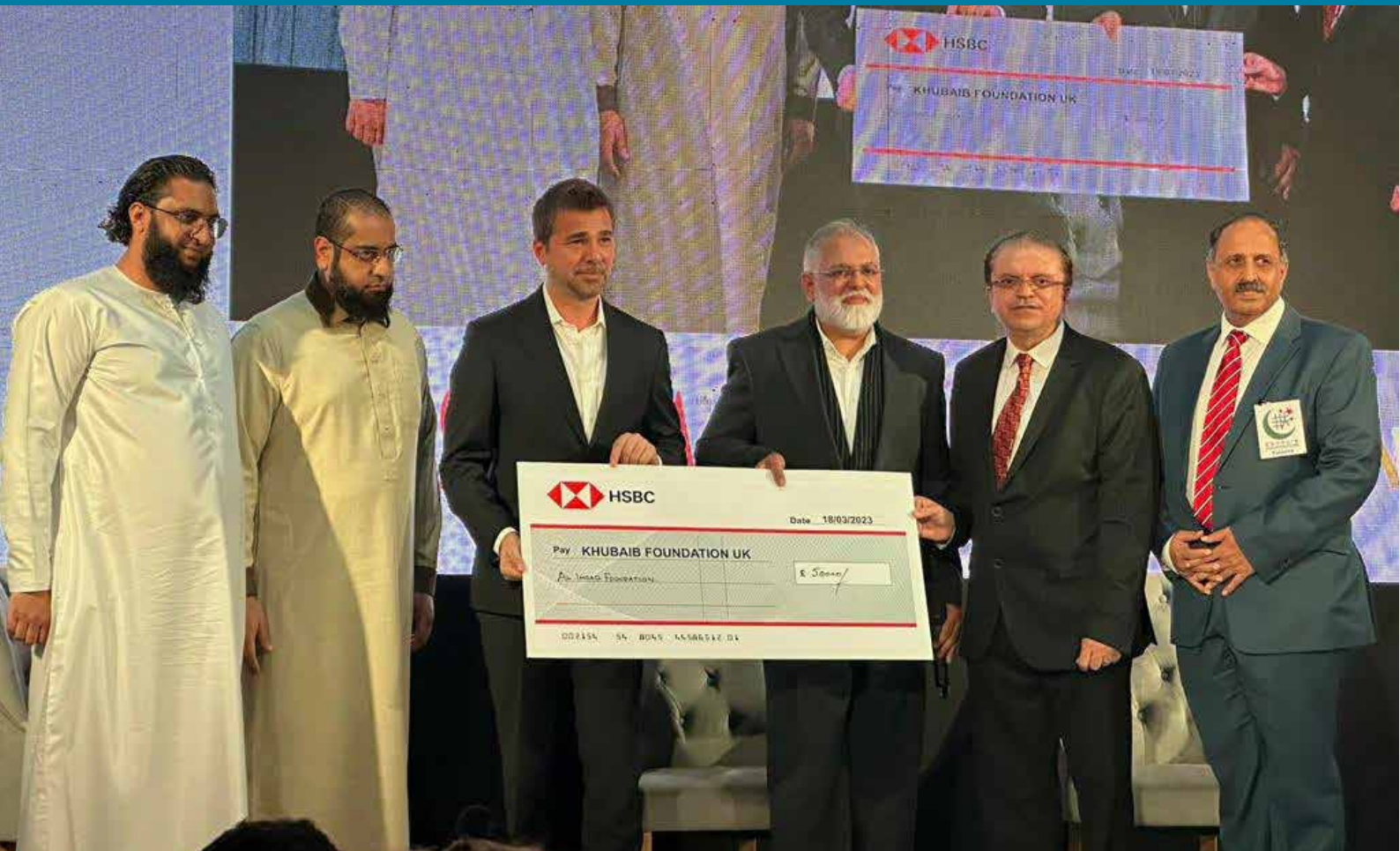
Visit of CZN BURAK

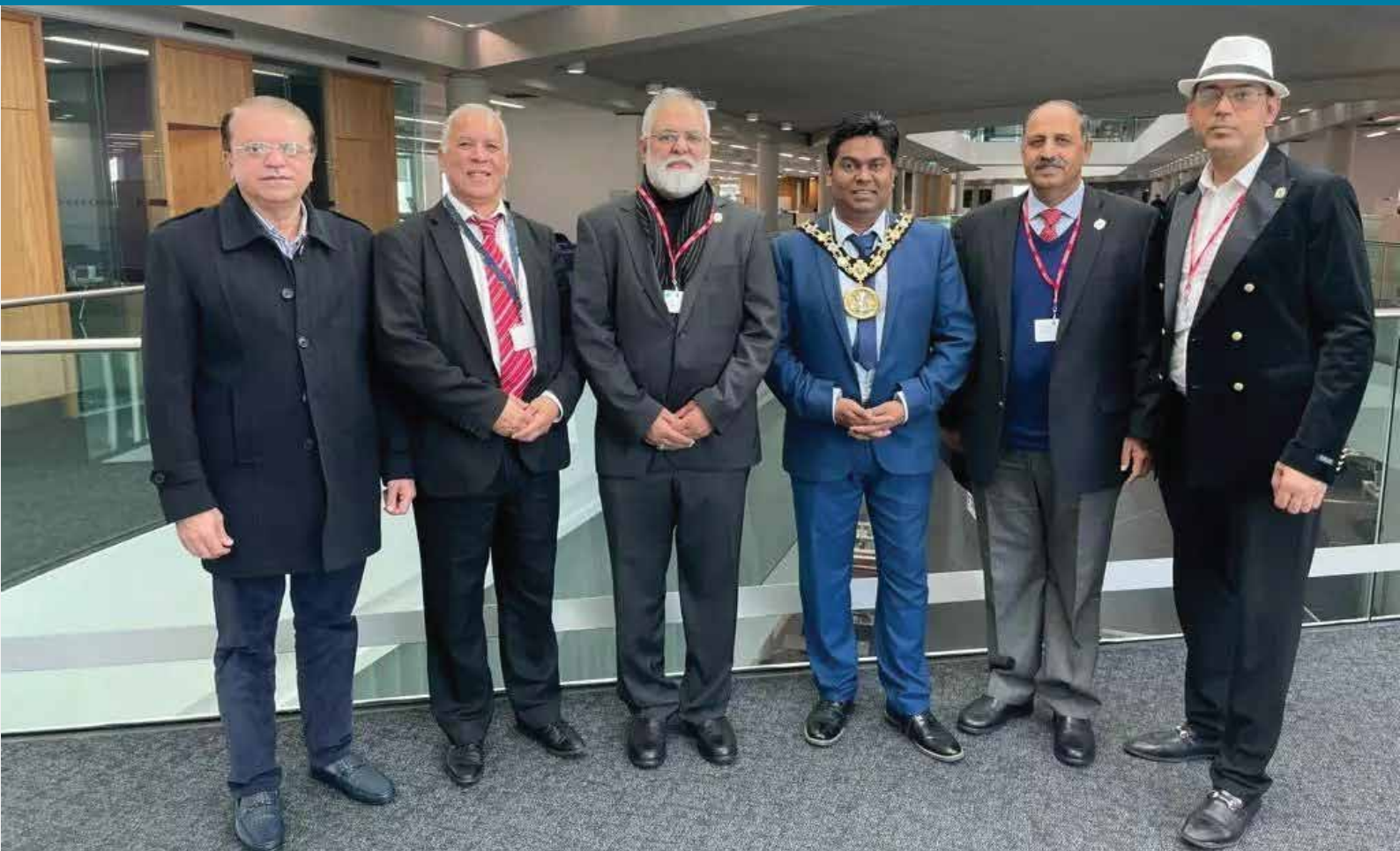
Khubaib Foundation UK
